TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

On June 10, 2010, a hearing on Plaintiffs' Request for a Temporary Restraining

Order in the above-styled action was held. After considering the <sup>agreement of</sup> requests and arguments of ~~parties~~ counsel, the Court finds ~~Plaintiffs are entitled to a Temporary Restraining Order.~~ <sup>that the parties have agreed to the entry of</sup> Plaintiffs are

~~entitled to a Temporary Restraining Order with notice to the Defendant because it is imminent~~

~~that the Defendant, Texas Green Party, will nominate its slate of candidates certify them, and forward them to the Secretary of State for inclusion on the ballot.~~

~~Plaintiffs are entitled to a Temporary Restraining Order because it is probable they will prevail against Defendant, Texas Green Party, and obtain a permanent injunction and/or mandamus. If the Temporary Restraining Order is not granted, irreparable harm is imminent, because the Texas Green Party's convention occurs June 11-12, 2010. Plaintiffs have no adequate remedy at law because the damages from Defendant's anticipated unlawful conduct are incalculable and could not serve as adequate compensation for the wrong inflicted on Plaintiffs and the voters of the state.~~

THEREFORE, the Court:

*WAC*  
ORDERS that the Texas Green Party and KAT SWIFT, in her capacity as Chairwoman of the Texas Green Party, or anyone acting on their behalf or at their direction, are enjoined from certifying its slate of candidates and forwarding same to the Secretary of State. <sup>For 14 days</sup> Furthermore, *from June 12, 2010 or anytime before if allowed by law.* that the Texas Green Party and KAT SWIFT, in her capacity as Chairwoman of the Texas Green Party, or anyone acting on their behalf or at their direction, are enjoined from taking any measures to certify its slate of candidates or obtain access for them to the 2010 Texas General Election Ballot. It is further

*WAC*  
~~ORDERED that the Texas Green Party and KAT SWIFT, in her capacity as Chairwoman of the Texas Green Party, or anyone acting on their behalf or at their direction, are enjoined from proposing and/or certifying any candidate.~~

*WAC*  
~~ORDERED that the TGP and Defendant Swift produce for a deposition, before the injunction hearing, all those individuals under their control and subject to the jurisdiction of the Court and with knowledge pertaining to this case. It is further ORDERED that TGP and Defendant Swift produce to TDP at or before the depositions any documents concerning the transactions described in the Original Petition including all correspondence and e-mails in their~~


possession by, between or among any defendant or any other person relating to the circumstances at issue in this case.


Plaintiffs are ORDERED to post a bond of \$ 0.
