TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

On June 24^{*}, 2010, a hearing on Plaintiffs' Request for a Temporary Injunction in the above-styled action was held. After considering the requests and arguments of counsel, the evidence and the exhibits, the Court finds Plaintiffs are entitled to a Temporary Injunction. Plaintiffs are entitled to a Temporary Injunction because it is imminent that the Defendant, Texas Green Party and its Chair Defendant Christine Morshedi, will certify its slate of candidates to the Secretary of State for inclusion on the 2010 General Election ballot.

Plaintiffs are entitled to a Temporary Injunction because it is probable they will prevail against Defendants, Texas Green Party and Morshedi, and obtain a permanent injunction and/or



mandamus. Plaintiffs have no adequate remedy at law because the damages from Defendant's anticipated unlawful conduct are incalculable and could not serve as adequate compensation for the wrong inflicted on Plaintiffs and the voters of the state. Plaintiffs are entitled to an injunction pursuant to Texas Election Code 273.081. Plaintiffs are entitled to a mandamus against Defendant Morshedi as a Party Officer of the Texas Green Party who threatens violation of Texas Election Code provisions directing her to perform a ministerial act.

THEREFORE, the Court:


ORDERS that the Texas Green Party and CHRISTINE MORSHEDI, in her capacity as Chairwoman of the Texas Green Party, or anyone acting on their behalf or at their direction, are enjoined from certifying its slate of candidates and forwarding same to the Secretary of State. Furthermore, that the Texas Green Party and CHRISTINE MORSHEDI, in her capacity as Chairwoman of the Texas Green Party, or anyone acting on their behalf or at their direction, are enjoined from taking any measures to certify its slate of candidates or obtain access for them to the 2010 Texas General Election Ballot.

A hearing for a final trial on the merits in this case is set for the 17th day of January, ²⁰¹¹2010, at 9:00 a.m./p.m.

Plaintiffs are ORDERED to post a bond of \$ 500⁰⁰.
